Mrs. Frances Elizabeth (Kelton) Frazier was born at Watkins Glenn, N. Y. on December 10, 1849 and died at her home in this city July 24, 1906, after an extended illness.

When five years old her parents moved to Illinois and remained there until she was 19 years old and then removed to Kellogg, Iowa.

When but 16 she was converted and became a member of the Baptist church but after removing to Kellogg she united with the Christian church, there being no church of her own denomination.
