## Clark Frost, 62, Lifelong Resident, Dies This Morning

Clark Frost, 62, a lifelong resident of Grinnell, died at 10:55 this morning at a local hospital after several years of failing health. He was taken to the hospital this morning and died shortly after arrival.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday at the Smith Funeral Home. Rev. E. E. Beattie will be in charge of the services. Friends may call at the funeral home for time of service.
