Lovilia Rites Held Wednesday For Kenneth Funk

Funeral services for Kenneth Loren Funk, 47, of Grinnell, were held Wednesday afternoon from the Zimmerman funeral home at Lovilia.

He died early Monday at Iowa Lutheran hospital in Des Moines of complications after being injured in a truck accident in Grinnell July 28th at the Macy Bros. Ready Mix Concrete Co. plant. He was manager of the plant.

Officiating at the services was the Rev. Donald Plum. Music was provided by Mrs. Janice Klobnak and Mrs. Jo Ann Klobnak. Pallbearers were Edward Renaud, John Williamson, Lester Holcomb, Don Lemke, Donald Farmer and Harold Byers, all of the Grinnell area. Interment was in Woodlawn cemetery at Lovilia.

The son of George F. and Nora Runnelis Funk, he was born Sept. 17th, 1916, at Lovilia. He attended the elementary schools of Lovilia.

On Feb. 17th, 1940, he was united in marriage with Lucille Moore of Knoxville.

A resident of Grinnell for the past seven years, he had lived at Searsboro and Lovilia previously.

Survivors include his wife, Lucille, of Grinnell; his son, Wayne, of Grinnell; three grandchildren; his father, George Funk of Albia; a sister, Mrs. Roy (Mildred) Jones of Lovilia; and two brothers, Lloyd Funk of Des Moines and Everett Funk of Portland, Ore.

His mother preceded him in death in 1953.
