

## Mrs. Gannaway <sup>45</sup> Dies in California <sup>71</sup>

Mrs. Mary H. McIntosh Gannaway, a longtime resident of Grinnell, died Monday (April 5) in Santa Barbara, Calif.

Memorial services for Mrs. Gannaway will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday, April 17, at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Newell E. Davis, minister of the Grinnell United Church of Christ-Congregational, officiating. Organist will be Elbert Smith.

Mrs. Gannaway was a 1902 graduate of Grinnell College and lived here for more than 60 years until moving to Santa Barbara last year. Her husband, John W. Gannaway, was also a 1902 Grinnell graduate and was a member of the college's political science faculty from 1908 until retiring in 1944. He died in 1947.

Active in the affairs of the college's Alumni Association, Mrs. Gannaway had served as agent for the class of 1902 since 1956. She had been a member of the Grinnell Advisory Council since its inception in 1963.

She was the daughter of Andrew and Addie Ricker McIntosh and was born on Dec. 19, 1880, in Grinnell. She attended the Grinnell schools and graduated with the Grinnell High School class of 1898.

On Oct. 24, 1906, she was married to John Gannaway. Following their marriage, the couple made their home in Milwaukee, moving to Grinnell in 1908.

Mrs. Gannaway is survived by her two sons, John and Robertson; six grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; one sister, Mrs. W. E. (Edna) Lyman of Des Moines; and one brother, Andrew McIntosh of Edmonds, Wash. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; a son, William; one grandchild; three sisters and two brothers.
