Walter H. Gant

Walter H. Gant, son of John and Iva Hinder Gant, was born April 17, 1882, at Searsboro. He received his education in the Iowa county schools. He was a member of the Victor Methodist church.

On June 19, 1906, he was married to Alta Slosser of Ladora and four daughters were born to the couple. The couple farmed in Iowa county until 1929 when they moved to a farm southeast of Brooklyn where they lived several years. Mr. Gant died Oct. 26, 1964, at the Lone Elm nursing home in Grinnell where he had lived the last ten years. He was 82 years old.

Survivors include four daughters, Mrs. Charles (Verla) La Kose of Springville; Mrs. Raymond (Wilma) See of Grinnell, Mrs. Delmar (Ila) Shultz of Victor and Mrs. Kenneth (Marjorie) Rhinehart of Hartwick; 13 grandchildren; 18 great-grandchildren; one sister, Mrs. Iva Vaughan of Alvin, Tex. and two brothers, Everett of Redfield and Leo of Ladora.
