

## Floyd B. Garver Rites Conducted

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Tuesday, July 13, at the Henderson Funeral Home in Toledo for Floyd B. Garver, 86, former Grinnell resident, who died Sunday afternoon, July 11, at the home of his daughter, Mrs. C. M. Kaisand, at Toledo.

The Rev. Donald Thompson of the Fairview United Methodist Church officiated at the services.

Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery in Grinnell.

The son of Benjamin S. and Jane Pittinger Garver, Mr. Garver was born Sept. 24, 1884, in Hart, Mich. He came to Iowa as a young man.

On Nov. 29, 1906, Mr. Garver married Ella Robison of Grinnell. The couple continued to live in Grinnell where Mr. Garver was a painter and interior decorator until 1941 when they moved to California. Mr. Garver lived in California until three years ago when he moved to Toledo to live with his daughter, Mrs. C. M. (Ruth) Kaisand.

Survivors include his daughter; two sons, Lyle and Edward, both of Gary, Ind.; nine grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild.

Mr. Garver was preceded in death by his wife in 1964, two sons, one daughter, one great-granddaughter, two sisters and four brothers.
