Clara Elizabeth Gause, daughter of Chris and Ida Lory, was born August 6, 1885 in Sardis, Ohio. At the age of two years she moved with her parents to Loveland, Colorado, where she grew to womanhood. She was educated in the rural schools, was graduated from the Boulder High School and attended two years at the State University at Boulder, Colorado. Following this she taught for two years in the rural schools in that area.

She was united in marriage to Lester H. Gause on August 5, 1908 in Windsor, Colorado. After living in Limon, Colorado for 6

years they moved to Iowa to the family farm south of Lynnville where they resided until 1947. In that year they returned to Colorado where they made their home at Windsor until 1958, when they returned to live in Lynnville.

The life of Clara Gause was characterized by cheerfulness and optimism and many will remember her helpful and kindly deeds. She derived great pleasure in being with her children and their families. Mrs. Clara Gause retained her membership in the Methodist church in Windsor, Colorado.

She was preceded in death by her parents, and two sisters, also three sons Elwin in 1922, Vern in 1935, and Lester Jr. in 1938.

Surviving is her devoted husband, Lester Gause and 4 sons, Lory of Lynnville, Dwight of Ta-

coma, Washington, Lowell and Ralph of Newton. There are 14 grandchildren; 9 great grandchildren; one brother, Dr. Charles Lory; and two sisters, Mrs. Mary Koenig of Ft. Collins and Mrs. Adda Ferguson of Windsor, Colorado.
