## Nellie D. George Dies Monday At Local Hospital

Nellie D. George, 75, a resident of Grinnell for the past 60 years, passed away Monday morning at a local hospital following an extended illness.

Funeral services for Mrs. George will be Wednesday at 2 p.m. at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home. Dr. G. S. Bruland will officiate and interment will be in Hazelwood Cemetery. Friends may call at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home.

Nellie Main, the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. Aaron Main, was born on January 5, 1885, at Searsboro, Iowa. In 1900 she moved to Grinnell and has made her home here for the past 60 years.

On November 23, 1904, she was united in marriage to W. W. Doud. To this union an infant son was born on May 6, 1906, and one month later passed away. Mr. Doud passed away on December 5, 1944, one week after they had celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary.

After her husband's death she purchased a home at 702 5th Avenue and lived there until she was married to Mr. C. S. George on June 25, 1947. They then moved to his home at 1001 West street and lived there until the death of Mr. George on March 9, 1953.

Mrs. George was a member of the Rebekah lodge.

She is survived by two sisters; Mrs. Cora Bailey of Greeley, Colo., and Mrs. John Ladikos of Sacramento, Calif.; and a brother, Josh Main of Searsboro. She was preceded in death by her parents, three brothers, Clarence, Charles and Aaron, and two sisters, Stella, and Effie.
