

May 7 John German. 1912

The funeral of John German, whose death at his home in Plankinton, S. D., was announced in the last issue of the Herald, was held from the Friends church at 2:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon. Rev. P. F. Marston conducted the services. The pallbearers were N. W. Cessna, W. T. Moyle, Frank Lane, G. M. Ross, G. W. Cole and Clarence Evans. Interment was in Hazelwood.

Many friends who knew Mr. German during his residence here, were present. Mr. German made his home just east of town until about seven years ago. He lived on two other farms in the vicinity of Turner and Kellogg and went to South Dakota two years ago.

He was 59 years of age. He passed away from heart trouble, after an illness of only a few days, leaving his wife and three children, two boys and a girl, to mourn the loss of a loving husband and father. The wife and one son attended the funeral.

A straightforward, upright man, Mr. German is sincerely mourned by all who knew him.
