Mrs. Gibson Dies; Funeral Saturday

Mrs. Florence Gibson, 49, the wife of Marion Gibson, died Wednesday evening at a local hospital a few hours after admission.

The daughter of LeRoy and Maggie Keenan Beason, Mrs. Gibson was born Feb. 17, 1918, at Malcom, Iowa. Her parents moved to the Grinnell community when she was a few months old and she received her education at the rural school, Grant No. 4, and Grinnell high school.

On Dec. 26, 1933, she was united in marriage with Marion Gibson at Waterloo, Iowa.

A life-long resident of Grinnell, she was presently employed by Grinnell College and previous to this by the Cargill Co. She was a member of the Methodist church.

Survivors include her husband, Marion; one daughter, Mrs. Paul (Shirley Anne) Jurgensen of Minneapolis; two sons, Vernon of Grinnell and Gary Lee at the family home; seven grandchildren; three sisters — Mrs. Emil (Iona) Darland of Evanston, Ill.; Mrs. Victor (Beatrice) Vulysteke of Grinnell; Mrs. Daniel (Hazel) Walker of Des Moines; and three brothers—Ernest Beason of Grinnell, Lester Beason of Inglewood, Calif.; and Alex Beason of Inglewood, Calif.

Mrs. Gibson was preceded in death by her parents and a brother Ted.

Funeral services for Mrs. Gibson will be Saturday at 10:30 a.m. at the James-Schalinske Funeral Home. The Rev. Chester E. Custer will officiate. Burial will be in Hazelwood cemetery.
