## Lynnville Rites Held Today For Grace Gifford

LYNNVILLE (Special) — Mrs. Grace Gifford, 89, died Oct. 21st at a Pella nursing home where she had been a patient since August.

Funeral services were held this afternoon (Monday) from the Lynnville Friends church with the Rev. Peter Shuler officiating. Organ music was provided by Mrs. Howard Macy. In charge of flowers were Mrs. Dwight Dailey, Mrs. Jim Terlouw and Mrs. Harold F. Macy.

Pallbearers were Harold F. Macy, Charles Bryan, Gerald Beason, Lory Gause, Ray Versteeg and William Stewart. Burial was in Woodland cemetery.

Born in Poweshiek county on July 18th, 1877, she was the daughter of Robert and Cynthia Ann English. She moved to South Dakota as a child and then came to Lynnville in 1885.

She was married to Charles Wildman in 1899 and they were the parents of four sons, Wayne of Pella, Dale of Ankeny, Keith of Pomona, Calif., and Hoyt, who died in 1955.

Her husband died in 1917 and she married A. T. Gifford in 1919. They were the parents of one son, Clair of Pella.

She was preceded in death by her second husband in 1957; a stepson, Ward Gifford in 1962, and a granddaughter, Judy Wildman.

Mrs. Gifford was a lifelong member of the W.C.T.U.
