Hugh Gilliland rites today

Hugh R. Gilliland, 82, of 710 Reed St., Grinnell, died Sunday, Dec. 18, at his home.

Funeral services were conducted at 1 p.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Harry Linnenbrink, pastor of St. Mary's Catholic Church, officiating. Organist was Kathleen Heffner, and pallbearers were Roger Bailey, John C. Davis, Mark Gilliland, Rick Gilliland, Rick Morrison and Gene Shook. Honorary bearers were Homer Allen and John Whannel.

Burial was at Hazelwood Cemetery.

The son of John A. and Rose Ivy Phipps Gilliland, he was born Nov. 30, 1901, at Fraser. He moved to South Dakota and then to Minnesota.

On July 3, 1926, he was married to Mary Stully at St. Paul, Minn. Following their marriage, they lived in St. Paul before moving to a farm near Montezuma. The couple moved to Grinnell in 1936, and Mr. Gilliland was employed in the buildings and grounds department of the Grinnell school system. From 1939 to 1974 he

worked for the Grinnell Shoe Factory and then the Morrison-Shults Glove Co.

He is survived by his wife Mary; his children, Rose Shockey of Newton, Alice Johnson of Grinnell, Hugh (Bud) Gilliland of Hartwick, Charles Gilliland of Grinnell, John Gilliland of Marshalltown, and Robert and William Gilliland, both of Grinnell; 21 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, five brothers and one sister.
