

## Wilhem Gloe Services Held 1/15/74

Funeral services for Wilhelm Gloe, 75, of Davenport, formerly of Brooklyn, were held at 2 p.m. Thursday in the Nevenhoven Funeral Home, Brooklyn. Mr. Gloe died early Tuesday morning in the Osteopathic Hospital in Davenport.

The Rev. Richard Menzel, pastor of the United Presbyterian Church of Brooklyn, officiated, and burial was in the I.O.O.F. Cemetery.

The son of Frank and Mathilda Springer, he was born July 8, 1898, near Brooklyn. He attended the Brooklyn schools, and later was employed by the International Harvester plant in Rock Island, Ill., for 33 years, retiring eight years ago. Since his retirement, he had lived in Davenport and the McAllen, Tex., area.

Mr. Gloe was a member of the Lutheran faith.

Survivors include one sister, Mrs. John (Anna) Edelen of Brooklyn; one niece; and three nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and four brothers.
