

Mabel Goff, Here 50 Years Dies Tuesday

Miss Mabel Goff, 918 Chatterton, 50 years resident of Grinnell, died Tuesday morning at a local hospital. She was 83 years old. Miss Goff had been in failing health for a number of years.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock from Smith Funeral Home. Rev. John DeLong, pastor of the First Methodist church, will officiate.

Daughter of the late William Goff and Anna Heginbotham, she was born Feb. 1, 1872 at St. Lewisville, Ohio. She came to Grinnell 50 years ago from Brooklyn, Ia., where she had attended school.

Miss Goff was employed by Child Art Studio and Preston Photographers at Grinnell as a touch up artist for many years.

She was amember of the Order of Eastern Star, White Shrine and was active in the Methodist church.
