Charles Good rites are held

Charles Richard Good died at Grinnell General Hospital on Friday Sept. 22. He was 55.

Funeral services for Charles R. Good were held at 1:30 p.m. on Sept. 25 at the Steffy Funeral Home in Montezuma. Music was provided by Mrs. Dennis Johnston, and the Rev. Martin Gruneich officiated.
