

Alice Goodlow services held

Alice L. Goodlow, 89, of Montezuma died Thursday, Jan. 20, at the Brookhaven Nursing Home.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the United Methodist Church in Montezuma, with the Rev. John Darlington officiating. Burial was at the I.O.O.F. Cemetery, Montezuma, with the Watts Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The daughter of Willard and Mary Bramer Dunton, she was born Oct. 21, 1893, near Brooklyn. She attended rural school near Brooklyn, graduating from Brooklyn High School. She taught school until her marriage to Elza Goodlow on Dec. 30, 1914. The couple farmed near
