Joseph Goodman, 66, formerly of Lake Ponderosa, died Thursday morning in Albuquerque, N. M. Dec. 11

Funeral services were Tuesday at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Haverhill with Fr. William O'Brien officiating. Burial followed at Immaculate Conception Cemetery. Visitation was Monday and a Knights of Columbus Rosary and a Parish Rosary were also offered that evening.

Joseph was born in Dubuque on December 11, 1929, the son of Vincent and Margaret Callahan Goodman. He was reared and educated in Dubuque, graduated from Loras Academy and attended Loras College. On August 28, 1950 in Haverhill, he married Gladys Neuroth.

The couple lived in St. Anthony,

Marshalltown and Haverhill before moving in 1987 to Montezuma, where they made their home at Lake Ponderosa for 10 years. Joseph was employed by Midland Transportation Company until his retirement.

Joseph was a member of St. Henry's Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus Third Degree and Teamsters Local 828.
