

Mrs. Mary C. Goodrich (VIRGIL)

Mrs. Mary C. Goodrich, 84, of Marengo and formerly of Brooklyn, died Saturday morning, June 22, 1996, in Mercy Hospital, Iowa City.

Funeral services for Mrs. Goodrich were held at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, in the First Presbyterian Church, Brooklyn. Rev. Aaron Koskamp officiated.
