Goodwin dies in Storm Lake

Vernon Goodwin, 52, of Storm Lake, died Monday, Feb. 21 at the hospital there following a long illness.

Funeral services for Vernon Goodwin were held at the Hughes-Nelson Funeral Home in Storm Lake on Feb. 24, with Dr. James Poulsen, pastor of the Methodist Church there, officiating. Burial was at the Storm Lake cemetery.
