Mrs. H. J. Gordon Dies In Burlington

Mrs. Henry J. (Carmen) Gordon, Brande Apartments in Grinnell, died Friday morning, February 12, in Burlington, Iowa, according to word received by Grinnell friends.

She had been in poor health for a few months, and had been a resident in a Burlington nursing home prior to her passing.

Mrs. Gordon was a long-time member of the United Methodist church of Grinnell, where she had served at one time as president of the Women's Society for two years. She was also a member of the Historical and Literary Club of Grinnell, the Order of the Eastern Star, the D.A.R., as well as other local organizations.

Her late husband, Henry J. Gordon, was for many years resident manager of Swift & Company's Grinnell plant.

Funeral services for Mrs. Gordon were this (Monday) afternoon at two o'clock in the Brant Clement chapel in Ft. Madison.

Survivors include: two sons, M. B. of Fort Madison, and Giles of Utica, Michigan; a daughter, Mrs. Leroy (Geraldine) Anderson of Reseda, California; two brothers; a sister; six grandchildren; five great grandchildren; and several nephews and nieces. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, three brothers and one sister.
