George B. Graff

George B. Graff, 88, Livermore, Calif., formerly of the Sheridan and Chester communities, died Nov. 12 in Livermore from complications following a stroke.

A memorial service was held Wednesday, Nov. 16, in Cedar Grove Community Church in Livermore. Burial of the cremains will take place at a future date in the Sheridan Cemetery.

He was born in Sheridan Township on Aug. 16, 1906, to George E. and Elizabeth Martin Graff and was raised in the Sheridan community. He was married in 1928 in Barnes City to Helen Core and the couple farmed in Chester Township until they retired in 1964 and moved to Long Beach, Calif. Following a stroke, Mr. Graff moved to Livermore in 1992 to be closer to his family.

He is survived by one daughter Carma Nordyke, Livermore, and one son Kenneth Graff, Carlsbad, Calif.; seven grandchildren and nine great grandchildren and one sister, Helen Schrock, Baxter. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife and one brother Alan.
