## ROBERT G. GRAY WAS EWART PIONEER

Funeral Services for Old Resident  
Were Held Last Friday  
Afternoon.

Ewart, Iowa, July 28 (Special)—Another old soldier and pioneer of Pleasant township and Poweshiek county has passed on in answer to the last bugle call.

Robert Gray died at his home in Ewart Wednesday morning, July 22, his age at that time being 86 years, one month and 15 days. He had been in failing health for a number of years.

Only a week before his death he was able to walk out in the yard where he could visit with his friends and neighbors by whom he is going to be greatly missed as he always had a kind and pleasant word for all.

Funeral services were held in the U. P. church at Ewart and were conducted by Rev. S. Walton Fay of Muscatine and Rev. R. E. Lackey of Ewart.
