## Services Friday For Mary Green

Mrs. Mary Green, 57, of 323 West St., died Wednesday morning at a local hospital, after an extended illness.

The daughter of Joseph and Julia Simon, Mrs. Green was born on Nov. 1, 1910, in New Jersey, where she received her education. She lived in Lorain, Ohio, and Chicago, Ill., before coming to this community in 1940.
