## Paralysis Is Fatal To Greenwald Boy

Raffety Greenwald, 15-year-old Grinnell High school junior, died at 11:10 a. m. Tuesday at the Community hospital after a five day battle against infantile paralysis. He was taken ill last Friday and his condition was critical almost from the first.

Private services were conducted at the grave in Hazelwood cemetery this morning by Rev. C. A. ~~Carmen of Chicago, former pastor~~ of the Grinnell Baptist church.

Son of Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Greenwald, living north of Grinnell, Raffety was a quiet, unassuming chap who was well liked and always on the friendliest of terms with all his schoolmates. He was a conscientious student and looked forward to a business career in preference to farming.
