The son of John and Ruth Ann Roberts Gregson, he was born at Kimball, S.D., on April 21st, 1884. When he was a young child, the family moved to the Ewart, Iowa, neighborhood to a farm. He attended the schools near his home.

Feb. 23, 1905, he was married to Agnes Aleanor (Lena) Souter at Ewart. To this union were born six children, five of whom survive: Mrs. Edith Foster of Marengo: Willard L. Gregson of Algona; Mrs. Glenn (Lavell) Cashmere of Tucson, Ariz.; Mrs. Ernest (Opal) Bonstetter of Corwith: and Kenneth W. Gregson of Mason City. Their mother passed away on Jan. 12th, 1917.
