## Ada Griewe services held

Ada F. Griewe, 86, of Grinnell died of Alzheimer's disease Thursday, July 14, at St. Francis Manor.

Funeral services were conducted at 10 a.m. Monday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Raymond Lott of the Grinnell United Methodist Church officiating. Graveside services were conducted at 3 p.m. at the Ell Township Cemetery, Klemme, with the Rev. Herb Shafer, pastor of the Klemme United Methodist Church, officiating.
