

Saturday Rites For Floyd Griffith

Funeral services were conducted at Bramer Funeral home Saturday afternoon for Floyd Griffith, long time Malcom and Brooklyn area resident who died July 17 in an Iowa City hospital.

Rev. Richard Menzel of the Presbyterian church officiated and burial was in I.O.O.F. cemetery. The casket bearers were Kenneth, Brett, Danny, Richard and Charles Griffith and Larry Walz.

Flower attendants were the Leo Rhineharts and William Dales.

Mr. Griffith, son of Nathan and Mecia Griffith, was born Dec. 30, 1894, at Petersburg, Ind. and died July 17, 1969.

He lived in Iowa the last 40 years after spending his earlier years in Indiana. He moved from Malcom to Brooklyn in 1943. During these years, Mr. Griffith drove a lime truck until his retirement.

On Jan. 8, 1916 he and Lula Davenport were united in marriage.

Preceding him in death were his parents, two sisters and one brother.
