Elmer Grundwald was born March 24th, 1894 at Camp Point, Illinois, and died at his Grinnell home September 3rd, 1955.

The son of Charles and Minna Zeiger Grundwald, he was united in marriage on February 12, 1917, with Elsie Weisheit. A resident of Illinois most of his life, he moved to Grinnell in 1918 to assume the managerial position of the Kirkpatrick warehouse.
