Mrs. Ida Hadley, Mother Of Local Woman, Succumbs

Ida M. Hadley, 79, of Des Moines, died Wednesday evening at a Grinnell hospital following an extended illness.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon from the Hamilton funeral home at Des Moines. Officiating was the Rev. Reuben Eversman, pastor of the Salem United Church of Christ of Alleman.
