Funeral Services Saturday For Mrs. Lula Hafkey

Mrs. Lula Amelda Hafkey, 82, Grinnell, died early this morning (Thursday) at a rest home in Newton. She had been in ill health for the past seven months and had resided at the rest home for five months.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday from the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Roland Wendell, pastor of the Chester Congregational church, officiating.

She was born Oct. 5th, 1879, the daughter of Irwin and Kathryn Dimit Bean, in Tama county. She was united in marriage with George F. Hafkey on Dec. 1st, 1902, in the Methodist parsonage at Grinnell, by the Rev. W. P. Stoddard. Mr. Hafkey preceded her in death in 1936.

After their marriage they farmed in Chester township until 1929, and then moved to Brooklyn where they lived for three years. In 1932 the family moved to Grinnell where she had made her residence until five months ago.

Mrs. Hafkey is survived by one son, Howard G. Hafkey of Newton; a brother, Oliver Bean of Grinnell; one grandson, Jack E. Hafkey of River Vale, N. J.; and three great grandchildren, Jeffrey, Jennifer and Erik Hafkey, all of River Vale, N. J.

She was preceded in death by her husband, George; her parents; one daughter, Mrs. Vera Hafkey Weeber; one brother, Ralph Bean; and one sister, Miss Pearl Bean.
