

## Funeral Services Held For Mrs. Hagenlock

Funeral services were held Thursday, Dec. 9 at the Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Gettysburg, S. Dak., for Mrs. W. L. (Della) Hagenlock, 73, a former Grinnell-area resident, who died in Dakota Midland Hospital in Aberdeen S. Dak., Monday, Dec. 6.

The Rev. R. E. Utecht, pastor of the church, officiated at the services.

Burial was in Gettysburg Cemetery with Langslet Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Hagenlock was born June 15, 1898 at Adel, Iowa. She grew up in the Grinnell area.
