

*HAINES, Charles*  
**College's oldest  
alumnus dies**  
*July 26, 1982*

Charles H. Haines, 105, who had been Grinnell College's oldest living alumnus, died Wednesday, July 21, in Denver, Colo.

A philosophy major at Grinnell, Haines also worked on the student newspaper and was a member of Phi Beta Kappa. He graduated from Grinnell in 1898, studied law at the University of Iowa, and received his LL.B. degree from Harvard Law School in 1904. He served as assistant city attorney for the city of Denver.

Both of his parents graduated from Grinnell College in 1865. His two sisters and three brothers were also Grinnell graduates.
