Lloyd L. Hall, 74, of Brooklyn, died Tuesday, May 8, 2001 in Friendship Manor Care Center in Grinnell.

Services were held Thursday, May 10, 2001 with Rev. Richard Okumu officiating. Interment was in Calvary Cemetery. Brooklyn

Lloyd LeRoy Hall, son of John LeRoy Hall and Pearl Mae Montgomery Hall, was born May 29, 1926, on a farm near Brooklyn. He received his education in a rural school and then Brooklyn High School, graduating in 1942.

On March 10, 1947, Lloyd was married to Bernadine Marie LaKose in St. Patrick's Catholic Church. Lloyd was baptized in the Catholic Church.

Lloyd farmed for many years and worked at the Brooklyn Cemetery from 1958 to 1974. He worked for the City of Brooklyn in the water-sewer department for fourteen years retiring in 1988. In 1966, he and Bernadine moved into Brooklyn.
