## Former Resident Dies In Newton

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. tomorrow (Tuesday) for Mrs. Martha Hall, 78, of Newton, a former Grinnell resident, who died Saturday afternoon in Newton.

The services will be held at the Toland Funeral Home in Newton with the Rev. Marlowe Reinholdt, pastor of the Immanuel Baptist church officiating. Burial will be in the Newton Memorial Park cemetery.

The daughter of George and Isabel Slagel Sandusky, Mrs. Hall was born on May 29, 1889 at Mt. Pisgah, Ky. She lived most of her life in Grinnell where she was married to William F. Hall.

Survivors include two sons — William of Villa Park, Ill., and Rex of Newton; two brothers, and three sisters.
