Rites held for Suzanne Hall

Suzanne Hall, 74, of 2095 Spring St., Grinnell, died Friday, Nov. 2, at Mercy Hospital in Iowa City.

Funeral services for Mrs. Hall were conducted at 11 a.m. Monday at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn, with the Rev. Lynn Williams of the Brooklyn Presbyterian Church and the Rev. Daniel Ogata of the First Presbyterian Church of Grinnell officiating. Pallbearers were Curt Kriegel, Blair Hall, Richard Siek, Duane Hendrickson, Todd Hartnell and Chris Hartnell.

Burial was in the I.O.O.F. Cemetery, Brooklyn.

The daughter of Marion A. and Carl Leach Fauver, she was born May 23, 1910, in Springfield, S.D. She lived in South Dakota and Logan and Belle Plaine before moving with her parents to Brooklyn in the early 1920s. She graduated from Brooklyn High School in 1928.

On June 15, 1933, she was married to Clarke J. Hall in Brooklyn, and they farmed south of that community. Mr. Hall died on Dec. 2, 1983, and Mrs. Hall subsequently became a resident of Grinnell. For many years she was a private piano teacher and also operated the Brooklyn Theater.

She was a member of the First United Presbyterian Church of Brooklyn and the Social Service Club and was a past matron of the Order of Eastern Star.

Survivors include two sons, Roger of Malcom and Clarke Jr. of Mound View, Minn.; one daughter, Mary Hartnell of Normal, Ill.; one brother, Marion J. Fauver of Omaha, Neb.; six grandchildren and seven great-children.
