Iona Leelia Halterman, 87, of Rogers, Ark., formerly of Grinnell, died Monday, May 19, at Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville, Ark.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Robert C. Smith, pastor of the First Baptist Church of Knoxville, officiating. Organist will be James Severe.

She was married to Paul Donald Halterman June 21, 1931, in Grinnell. They owned and operated Paul's Hatchery in Grinnell for a number of years. She later was employed as a bookkeeper for Mitchell Buick Garage.

Following her husband's death, she continued to live in Grinnell until moving to Rogers in 1972.

She was a member of the Grinnell First Baptist Church, Grinnell Rebekah Lodge, Beulah Chapter No. 47 of the Order of Eastern Star, the Newton White Shrine and, in Rogers, the American Legion Auxiliary, Oak Hill Grange and Art Guild.
