## Rites Held for Mr. Halterman

Marion N. Halterman, 74, of Newton, formerly of Grinnell, died Thursday morning (Mar. 21) at Iowa Methodist Hospital in Des Moines.

The son of Charles D. and Lillian Brown Halterman, he was born Sept. 18, 1899, in Grinnell. He attended the Grinnell public schools.
