

Funeral Of Mrs. J. F. Hannay Sat.

Margaret Rankinc was born at Falkirk, Scotland, October 24, 1840, and died September 5, 1929, aged nearly 89 years. She was united in marriage with Mr. John F. Hannay, January 17, 1862. Their wedded life continued unbroken nearly 64 years. To this union were born three daughters and three sons—all of whom are still living, together with three grandsons and one granddaughter. Mr. Hannay was a teacher at Carsphairn, Scotland, where all their children were born. In 1883 the family came to America and made a home in Scott County, Iowa. In 1887 they purchased a large farm near Grinnell, on which they resided until the death of Mr. Hannay in November, 1925.

Mrs. Hannay was a woman of strength and beauty. She did her share of the labor necessary with a large family on a large farm. She spoke in well chosen words with a Scotch accent that was charming to hear; to meet her was a pleasure, to know her intimately was to have a valued friend. She loved her home, the well regulated household, the flowers in her garden; she loved her family, she loved her husband, her children and grand children. She loved her Saviour; her religious life was a genuine devotion to God in whom she had all faith. She had been a member of the Congregational Church of Grinnell since 1887. Funeral services were held at the home in Grinnell, 1022 Park St., Saturday, September 7. All her children and grandchildren were present, together with many neighbors.
