G. W. HARRISON

George White Harbison was born in Pittsburg, Penn., July 28th, 1832, and died Sept. 15th., 1906, at Grinnell, aged 74 years, 1 mo., and 17 days.

He came to Iowa in 1857 and assisted during the civil war in the 2nd Iowa Reg. in 1861. He served his country well and fought bravely for the cause which he advocated, until he was honorably discharged in 1864.

On Nov. 13th, 1864, he was united in marriage to Jane Edwards. From this union ten children were born, eight of whom survive him. His good wife preceded him to the eternal world Nov. 13th., 1905.

He was a good man, honest and upright in his relations to his fellow men, a kind husband and a most loving father. He suffered much for several years, but now he suffers no more.

Monday, Sept. 17th, 1906, the funeral services were held in the little church 5 miles south west of Grinnell and interment was made in Westfield cemetery near by.

The services were conducted by Rev. D. Phillips of Malcom, who had also conducted Mrs. Harbison's funeral in November.

May God bless and keep the children and prepare them all for a blessed reunion on the other side of death and the grave.
