

Kellogg man dies in truck-'cycle crash

Craig Allen Harding, 28, of Kellogg was killed Friday when his motorcycle was struck from behind by a pickup truck near the Maytag Co. plant. July 11

A second motorcyclist, Michael Patterson, 29, was treated at a Newton hospital and released.

Authorities said Harding and Patterson were riding their motorcycles at 12:20 a.m. on Nineteenth St. N. in Newton when the accident occurred.

The driver of the pickup truck left the scene. As of Friday, no arrests had been made, although a truck believed to have been the one involved had been located.

Harding was reported dead at the scene, having sustained massive head injuries.

Funeral services were scheduled for 10:30 a.m. today at the Reese Chapel in Newton, with burial at the Newton Union Cemetery.
