Mrs. Katie Josephine Harrington.

Mrs. Katie Josephine Harrington passed away at her home, 626 Park street, on Friday night, at 10:30 o'clock, aged 71 years. She had been ill three years from uraemic poisoning. The funeral was held Sunday at 9:00 o'clock from Kibby & Benson's store, and the body was taken to Chester Center for interment beside those of her husband and two children. Rev. L. D. Weyand conducted the funeral services. Flowers were sent by the Women's Relief Corps and the pallbearers were all members of the G. A. R. Mrs. Harrington was Kate Josephine Fitzalbert. She was born in England and after crossing the ocean three times with her uncle, a sea captain. She was married in New York about 1856, to John Harvey Harrington. In 1858 they moved to Gilman and later to Grinnell. Of four children, one daughter, Ina Harrington, survives.

Mrs. Harrington was one of Grinnell's pioneers, much loved and highly respected by all who knew her. Her long life in this community has given her a place which cannot be filled. The sorrowing family have the sympathy of all in their loss.
