 Bert Harris was born July 20th, 1890 at Oak Grove and died January 14th, 1955 at Grinnell.

The son of William and Ida Harris, he lived in Grinnell most of his life except for a few years spent at Oak Grove and Gilman.

He received his education in the Grinnell public schools and on August 24th, 1915, he was married at Des Moines to Katherine Steen. From this marriage was born one son, William F. Harris who died in 1948. His wife died in 1921.

Surviving are his grandson, William F. Harris, Detroit.
