Frank Albert Harris, a farmer in the Grinnell area, passed away on Wednesday morning, March 13, 1957, at a local hospital, at the age of 59 years, four months and 21 days.

Mr. Harris was born in Chester on October 22, 1897, the son of Thomas and Caroline Harris. In his boyhood he attended the rural schools of Chester township and he joined the Sonora Methodist church as a youth.

He began farming with his father as a young man and continued until the death of his father in 1944. He and his mother then moved to a smaller farm where Mr. Harris lived until his death.
