Harvey T. Harris, 84, of Rte. 3, Grinnell, died Monday, Sept. 28, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Grinnell Christian Church, with the Rev. Kenneth Wallace, pastor of the Chester United Church of Christ, officiating. Organist will be Alice Renaud.
