## 4-19-1932 Peter Harter

Peter Harter passed away Wednesday evening, April 6 at 8:45 at the Skiff Memorial hospital at Newton following a five day illness of pneumonia. He was aged 73 years, 4 months and 12 days.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday morning from St. Mary's church by Rev. Father M. J. Hannon. Pall bearers were C. L. McNally, Ross Coutts, Alex Dev-  
ereaux, Emery Schmitz, John Linden and M. W. Flanagan. Interment was in Hazelwood.

Peter Harter was born Nov. 24, 1858 at Weingarten, Germany, coming to America in 1882. He was united in marriage June 2, 1882 to Eva Heisel also from Germany. They made their home in Newburg, Iowa for a short time, later moving to Grinnell where they lived for 12 years. They then moved to a farm at Oak Grove and later to a farm at Westfield where they lived until 19 years ago, when they moved to their present home in Grinnell.

He is survived by his wife, one son and four daughters; John Harter south of Grinnell, Mrs. Lena Foster of Newburg, Mrs. Mary Swart of Aryshire, Iowa, Mrs. Anna Wortman of Grinnell, and Mrs. Elizabeth Hotchkin of Newburg. One daughter died in infancy. He is survived also by 18 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren, and a host of friends. They would have celebrated their golden anniversary this year.
