

Frank Hartley

Frank Hartley, 83, of Musella, Ga., formerly of Grinnell, died Saturday, June 8, at his home.

A memorial service will be conducted at 7 p.m. Tuesday, July 9, at the Smith Funeral Home in Grinnell. There will be no visitation.

He was the son of George Herbert and Margret Elizabeth Taylor Hartley and was born June 8, 1913, in Nottinghamshire, England. He was a veteran of the British Army, serving in China from 1929 to 1936 and in France and Germany from 1939 to 1945. He was a member of the Church of England.

Before emigrating to the United States, Mr. Hartley was the manager of an English estate. He came to the U.S. in June 1963. In September 1964, he was married to Doris I. Meyers.

Mr. Hartley was employed by Manatts Inc. and, from 1967 to 1978, by Miracle Recreation Equipment Co. He became a U.S. citizen May 1, 1972. After his retirement from Miracle, he became a full-time groundskeeper for Claude Ahrens of Grinnell. He and his wife moved to Musella in October of last year.

He was a member of the Grinnell Eagles Lodge.

Surviving are his wife; three stepchildren, 10 grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren and one sister, Mary Lloyd of Luton, England.
