## Rites Held For John Hartsock, 80, Lynnville Resident

John Winfield Scott Hartsock  
82, a resident of the Lynnville  
area for more than 60 years, died  
Sept. 24 at an Oskaloosa nursing  
home.

Funeral services were held Sunday, Sept. 27, at New Sharon with the Rev. William Oberlander officiating. Vocal music was provided by Homer McDowell, accompanied by Mrs. Howard Macy.

Together, they operated a restaurant in Lynnville for 30 years before retiring in 1958.

Mr. Hartsock had been in failing health for two years and had entered an Oskaloosa hospital in August. He was later transferred to a nursing home where he succumbed.
