

Prof. Hartson dies in Ohio

Prof. Louis D. Hartson, 92, formerly of Grinnell, died Sunday, Dec. 4, in Oberlin, Ohio, friends here have learned.

A memorial service was held Dec. 10 at the First Congregational Church in Oberlin. The body was donated to the Chase Western Reserve Medical School.

A native of Iowa, he was a 1908 graduate of Grinnell College. He served as alumni class agent for many years.

Prof. Hartson taught psychology and education at Grinnell College from 1911 to 1923, leaving here for Oberlin College where he became chairman of the psychology department.

He was married to Mary Reed, also a graduate of Grinnell College.

Surviving are two children, Robert of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, and Mary Beth McCalla of Sidney, Ohio.
