Mrs. Carrie Hartwig Dies; Graveside Rites At Kellogg Today

Graveside rites for Mrs. Frank (Carrie) Hartwig, 80, of Kellogg, were held this afternoon (Thursday) at Our Silent City cemetery at Kellogg. The Rev. Herbert Miller of the Kellogg Christian church presided.

Mrs. Hartwig, a longtime resident of Kellogg, died Tuesday at the hospital in Newton.

Survivors include: a sister, Mrs. Maggie Parsons of Grinnell; and a niece, Mrs. Elmer Starrett of Newton. Her husband preceded her in death, passing away in December of 1959.

Born May 20, 1885 in Kellogg, she was the daughter of Nels and Meta Peterson Buck. She was educated in the Kellogg schools. In December, 1907, she was married to Frank Hartwig in Kellogg.
