## Fred Hasley Rites Nov. 30 At Ottumwa

Funeral services for a former area resident, Fred Eugene Hasley of Ottumwa, were conducted there at the Jay Funeral Home on Saturday, November 30. The Rev. George Huffman of Batavia officiated.
